

## H. THE ALIBI

1) In pairs, imagine your alibi. Pay attention to the details: *What were you doing between 8 p.m. and 10 p.m. ? Where were you ? Who were you with ? ...*



2) One of you will leave the classroom while his/her mate will be questioned about his/her alibi. (The other students turn into police detectives.) Then the other student will be asked the same questions. The aim is to prove them guilty. Let's find out who is the most clever ...??!
