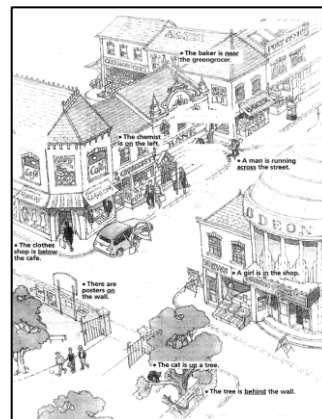

2. *Sir, can you tell me the way to the CAR PARK?*

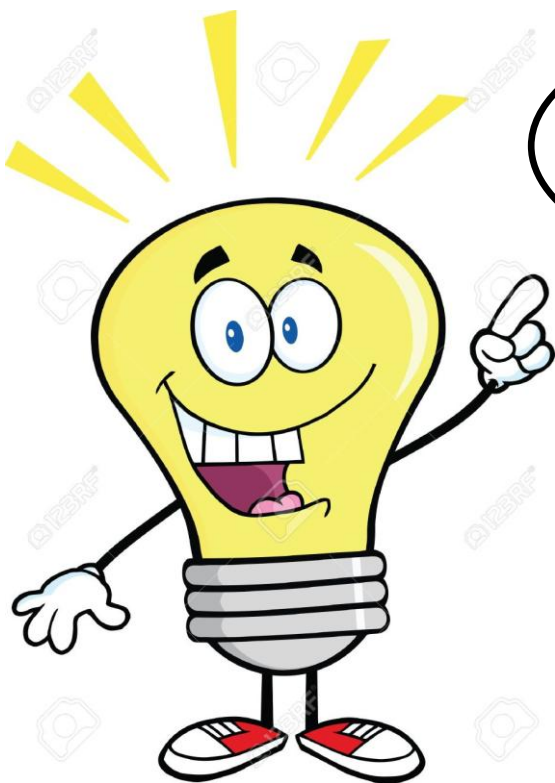

Yes, go down Lily Street. At the junction, turn left, go **PAST** the bank and it's right there, on your right, on the **CORNER** of Daisy Street and Rose Street.

4. *Can you help me, please? I'm lost and I would like to go to the gas station.*

Certainly, it's not far. Go **STRAIGHT** ahead along Violet Street. Take the first turning on the left. It's right there, **OPPOSITE** the park.
